Herbicides	32-50 ounces / 100 gallons solution





Q: Why am I using Wetcit with my rust application?

A: Applied at 50 oz/100 gal solution, Wetcit improves leaf coverage and uptake of the fungicide. Wetcit will also dry up and kill any live spores that the spray solution contacts at the time of application.

Q: Can I use Wetcit instead of an insecticide for aphid control?

A: When applied at 50 oz/100 gal solution, Wetcit will desiccate and kill soft-bodied insects within 24 hours. However, it has no activity on insects not contacted by the spray solution and there is no residual activity. Wetcit is intended to complement an insecticide application when warranted.

Q: Do I need to use a buffer when using Wetcit with an insecticide?

A: Wetcit has no buffering capability. Therefore, you will need to use Spectra pH in addition for those applications that require a buffer.

Q: Can Wetcit improve the activity of Roundup (glyphosate)?

A: We have seen improved activity on hard to control broadleaf weeds in chem fallow when Wetcit was applied with Roundup at 50 oz/100 gal solution.

Q: Can I use Wetcit with Roundup (glyphosate) in a pre-harvest application in legumes?

A: Wetcit should work well in this application providing superior coverage and uptake. You should continue to use a water conditioning product. In addition, there are no MRL concerns with the use of Wetcit.

Q: Can I use Wetcit to improve my control of mayweed in my winter wheat?

A: There are some broadleaf tank-mixes where Wetcit can be used to improve herbicide uptake. However, until further testing is done, we are not recommending Wetcit be applied in combination with any grass herbicide in cereals.
