ADJUVANT

M-90™

M-90 is a Nonionic Surfactant, Humectant, and Antifoaming Agent.

PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONING AGENTS

M-90 is a nonionic surfactant formulated for increasing the efficacy of various agricultural and horticultural spray applications. **M-90** should be used where wetting and uniform coverage of the spray is required. **M-90 is not for aquatic use.**



HAZARD STATEMENTS

- Causes serious eye irritation.
- Harmful if inhaled.
- May be harmful in contact with skin.
- May cause damage to organs [kidneys] through prolonged or repeated exposure.

PREVENTION

- Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or smoking tobacco.
- Wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), chemical-resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks when mixing or applying **M-90**.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product.
- Avoid breathing dust, fume, gas, mist, vapors or spray.
- Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.

FIRST AID

- Call a poison center or doctor/physician if you fell unwell.
- **IF SWALLOWED:** Rinse mouth. Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do NOT induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- **IF IN EYES:** Rinse continuously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do; continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice.
- **IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
- **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

STORAGE, DISPOSAL AND SPILL

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
- **STORAGE:** Store between 40° and 120°F. Store in original container only. Keep container tightly closed. Do not allow water to be introduced to this container. Avoid contact with aluminum, copper, zinc or mild steel containers or surfaces. Do not use or store near open flame.
- **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse or equivalent during mixing and loading and add rinse to spray tank. Recycling decontaminated containers is best option for disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program. To contact your State and local ACRC recycler, visit the ACRC web site at www.acrecycle.org. Do not contaminate water sources by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastewaters. Dispose of contents and container in accordance with local/national regulations.
- **SPILL:** If spill occurs, do not attempt to use water to clean-up as surface areas may become slippery. Just sweep unused material and/or empty package in sanitary landfill.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Before using **M-90**, always read and follow all label directions, mixing instructions and precautionary statements of the pesticide label that is to be tank mixed with this product. **M-90 is not for aquatic use.**

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

The following chart shows the **M-90's** suggested use rates per 100 gallons of spray mix. Rates of **M-90** may vary with the conditions of the application or due to recommendations of the pesticide label.

| Acaricides, Fungicides, Insecticides..... | 3 to 8 ounces |
| Herbicides..... | 1 to 3 pints |
| Defoliants, Desiccants, Plant Growth Regulators..... | 1 to 2 pints |
